Prune Your Elms:

- Keep your elms healthy by removing dead or dying branches using a professional tree pruner
- Do not prune between April 1st and August 31st

**Dispose of Elm
Wood Properly:**

- Do not use, store or transport elm wood. **It is illegal!**
- Take elm wood to the nearest designated disposal site

**Watch for the
Symptoms of DED:**

- As early as June watch for leaves that wilt, turn yellow, then curl and turn brown
